*Critical Review of Kalthoff*

The review exhibits a good understanding of the approach that was adopted in the research and of key issues relating to ethnography and, in this case, the application of grounded theory techniques in analysis. There has clearly been an attempt to apply a critical approach to the work and some valid points are made here without reducing the review to an assessment, but rather revealing the way in which the researcher's argument works.

*Research Proposal*

As with the critical review, the proposal demonstrates a sophisticated understanding of a range of methodological issues and techniques, with perhaps the single exception of a slightly misleading interpretation of the Hawthorne Effect. The work also evidences wide reading of relevant methodological sources and the project itself has been well thought through, is viable, and is likely to be productive.

Both pieces of work are well written and presented with strong lines of argument and good evidence of critical thinking.
