*Review of Lim & Chai*

The review evidences a sophisticated understanding of a range of methodological issues and this understanding is applied appropriately in engaging the reviewed article raising a number of relevant and important issues.

*Review of Murphy et al*

This review gets to the heart of the argument made in the reviewed paper and reveals difficulties with it by, in places, quite close reading of the methods deployed by the researchers. Again, the review exhibits a sophisticated understanding of a range of methodological issues.

*Proposal*

This is a very well framed and coherent proposal that includes a critical discussion of relevant research literature and thoughtful reflection on the issues involved in the research. The discussion of grounded theory is also relevant here. I would have liked to see some indication—even at this early stage—of the content of the interview schedule.

*General comments*

This is generally an excellent submission that is well presented and well argued and evidencing a wide range of reading of methodological and other research literature.
