*Critical Review of Nitta, Holley & Wrobel*

The review identifies a number of questions that are legitimately put to the reviewed research and exhibits, in general, a good understanding of methodological issues. There is a slip in the confusion of structural and composite description in phenomenological research.

*Research Proposal*

This is a thoughtful piece that evidences a good understanding of a range of methodological issues and presents a viable project. The candidate did not submit a draft for feedback, had he done so, one suggestion would have been that the clarity of a proposal benefits from the use of sections that correspond to the main methodological issues to be addressed in a research proposal rather than weaving (some of) these into the discussion of antecedent work.
